MIRANDA DOWNS MUSTER FOR UP TO FOUR PEOPLE

Peter and Jane Hughes offer a "Miranda Downs Muster" package for the first ever time at the AWA charity auction. Up to 4 people will be transported 1,400 km in the Hughes's private plane from Mackay Queensland to Miranda Downs Station in the Gulf of Carpentaria.

Miranda Downs is a 1 million acre cattle station located north of Normanton on the Gilbert and Maxwell rivers with more than 55,000 head running across 45 paddocks. Miranda Downs is a truly iconic piece of Australian Pastoral grazing history, now part of the Georgina Pastoral aggregation and changing its production systems to extensive Wagyu breeding and calf production.


As part of the Miranda Downs Muster, up to four people can be flown from Mackay Queensland to Miranda Downs. They will stay for three nights including:

DAY 1 Fly Mackay Queensland to Miranda Downs, meet the Miranda team and stay at Miranda prior to the Muster day.

DAY 2 Participate in the muster at Miranda Downs, including horse or vehicle operation under supervision and the opportunity to view the muster from a helicopter. Spend some time with the muster team that evening and stay at Miranda that night.

DAY 3 Participate in cattle working at Miranda and enjoy a final evening with the team before flying out.

DAY 4 Fly back to Mackay from Miranda Downs.
